Learning Catch-ups and Extension

CJC will provide students with catch-up and extension support throughout the year.



First Aid

- First Aid is located next door to the Main Office
- Medical conditions that require Action Plans, <u>Student Health Management Plan and Medication before the first day of school:</u>
- → Anaphylaxis
- → Asthma
- → Allergy
- → Other (diabetes, seizures etc)

School exclusion - students cannot attend school:

- Fever, vomiting, diarrhoea, sore throat, consistent cough or runny nose until 24 hours after symptoms have ceased
- Infectious disease, please advise the school
- Head lice (nits) until treatment has commenced, please advise the school

Administering medication at school

- Medication handled by adults only (except asthma pump)
- All medication provided by parents/carers clearly labelled with child name in original packaging
- Medication authority form signed by parent/carer

Students visiting the First Aid Room

- Compass email automatically sent to parents even minor injuries
- Parents contacted by phone if children need to be picked up or need to be assessed by a doctor
- Ambulance cover is recommended
