- Be positive!
- Develop a morning routine that is organised and timely.
- Promote independence including going to the toilet.
- Read lots of stories in multiple languages.
- Practise writing your child's name with them.
- Practise packing up and putting toys away.
- Play games it's ok if they lose!
- Have little snacks show them how to unwrap packets etc

Please read to your child every night. This will not only assist in their learning but will also nurture an interest in print. It is also a special time to bond with them and an excellent way to promote the minority language.

 Development of oral language – explain things, tell them what's happening at home, during the day, introduce many languages.




French Binational Program: Places are limited. 2023 Enrolments must close on Friday 20 May ! Please visit the <u>enrolment page</u> on our school website.
